## HOW TO TEST FLOW ON THE GAGGIA BABILA

- 1. Turn the machine off via the main power switch on the back of the machine
- 2. Wait 10 seconds, then turn the machine back on via the main power switch
- 3. While the Gaggia logo and progress bar are on the display, press the following buttons in an 'X' pattern: Special drinks, espresso, espresso lungo, and coffee. Please note, these buttons need to be pressed quickly, or you will not be able to access the tech menu.
- 4. A special technicians menu will appear on the display.
- 5. Press menu (down arrow) two times to get to the brew unit screen
- 6. Press the espresso button to put the brew unit in the work position. Work will now be highlighted on the display.
- 7. Press menu once to navigate to HYDR CIRCUIT ½
- 8. Press the espresso button to activate DcV 1. DcV 1 will now be highlighted.
- 9. Press menu once to navigate to HYDR CIRCUIT 2/2
- 10. Place a container under the coffee dispensing spout
- 11. Press the coffee button to activate Pmp1. Water should now begin to flow from the coffee dispensing spout. Take note of the number in the top right rectangle while water is being dispensed.
- 12. Press the coffee button to deactivate Pmp1.
- 13. Press the bean button twice to navigate back to the brew unit page.
- 14. Press espresso lungo to put the brew unit into home position. Home will now be highlighted on the display.
- 15. Press the menu button once to navigate back to HYDR CIRCUIT ½
- 16. Press Cappuccino to activate DcV 5. DcV 5 will now be highlighted
- 17. Press the menu button to navigate to HYDR CIRCUIT 2/2
- 18. Place a container under the manual frothing wand
- 19. Press special drinks to activate Pmp2. Water should now begin to flow from the manual frothing wand. Take note of the number in the top right rectangle while water is being dispensed.
- 20. You may now exit the tech menu. To do this, turn the machine off via the main power switch on the back of the machine.
